We apologize that we weren't able to get a September letter sent out. Praise the Lord Ezra is here, but his birth meant us spending a month at the hospital. Ezra was in the NICU for three and a half weeks. The surgeons squeezed his intestines into his body and closed up his belly. Then we prayed for poop, which finally came. Next our baby boy had to learn how to eat and gradually work up to full feeds before we could take him home.

God was so good to us during those weeks. 24 days is really fast for these Gastroschisis babies to get to go home. After having Ezra home only a week we took Ezra to urgent care when he wasn't acting like himself. Our baby boy ended up being helicoptered to St. Louis Children's Hospital and we discovered he was septic, a bacteria was growing in his blood. He is also having issues with his liver and his bowels.

After being on an IV antibiotic for 14 days we have finally returned home with a clean bill of health from the infection. Ezra will always have bowel issues and is currently on liver medication until we go to his follow up appointments. Please pray for his continued healing.

While being at the hospital is not an ideal situation, it is an ideal situation for ministry. When you are surrounded by 90 other sick babies and their parents, it is a mission field in itself. We had the opportunity to pray with several families, including some hospital staff. We ask that you remember some of these in your prayers. Please pray for baby Marvin, baby Kai, and baby Abdullah. Also remember their families. We saw God answer a lot of prayers while we were there. Please remember Ms. Loreal who has breast cancer. We also had the opportunity to share the Gospel with several families.
