We were able to visit and present in several ministries this last month, and God opened the windows of blessing on our little family. One example of this that we would like to share is of a loving church family here in Springfield. We were able to present our ministry and share about how God had healed Ezra and gave us opportunities to witness to several people in the NICU in St. Louis. After I preached what the Lord had laid on my heart, the Pastor stood up and asked how much we still owed the hospital for Ezra. After the insurance I'd had through Estes, and Medicaid we still had some out of pocket medical expenses that needed to be paid. The congregation took up an offering that more than covered the rest of Ezra's hospital bill! We are so grateful to the Lord for meeting all our needs, and thankful to all of our brothers and sisters in Christ for allowing God to use them to be a blessing to us.

Crazy Phone Call!

While we were in St. Louis for 2 months we were able to stay in the Ronald McDonald House. It was a huge blessing to our family. (I encourage you to throw some spare change in those red bins at your local McDonalds.) We did not have to worry about breakfast or dinner most days, and we had 24 hour access to all we could drink McDonald's coffee. It was also very close to the Children's hospital. However, contrary to popular belief the house is not free. If your insurance does not cover it, it costs \$15 a night.

Several people told us not to pay it, because it is "suggested." I made up my mind that I was going pay what I owed, because it was the right thing to do. Earlier this month we received a phone call from the Ronald McDonald house. The Ronald McDonald House financial administrator told Teah that they had been able to bill Ezra's Medicaid, and that we would be getting a refund check in the mail!! Praise the Lord!!

(Psalm 37:25) While I would not consider myself old yet, I have seen the truth of this verse over, and over in my life. God takes care of His children.
