Saturday April 20th nine young people prayed and made professions of faith. Eight of these young people were at our regular Saturday evening youth meeting, and the ninth young lady was from a church in the capital that Pastor Wesley and Mrs. Melina planted. This church was here in Jarabacoa for their annual church camp.

At youth The Holy Spirit led Joshua to preach the Gospel out of 1 Cor. 15. We also read the last part of Romans 16. In total we read 63 verses from God's Holy Word. It truly is God's Words, not our own words, that have the power to change hearts and lives. After the lesson, Joshua asked Pastor Wesley to give an invitation, during which 3 teen girls and 5 teen boys went to the altar. Teah prayed with the girls and Pastor Wesley prayed with the boys. Though we cannot know a person's heart, and Teah believes one of the girls that prayed, Samantha, is still struggling with truly accepting salvation or is at least struggling with assurance of her salvation, we are so grateful to have witnessed God working.
