Dengue fever is a real problem in the Dominican Republic right now. It has affected over 7500 people according to local newspapers. There have also been 10 confirmed Dengue related deaths this season. We praise Lord for Teah's recovery. We know many of you were praying fervently and we thank you for your labors in prayer.
