She told me afterwards that she grew up in a Pentecostal background and never felt like she belonged anywhere, but that she would definitely be back. The following Sunday I picked them up again, and much to my surprise her husband showed up later on his motorcycle. Rafael set through the preaching, and was very cordial as he assured me he would return. The following Sunday as I preached, I watched him

become very sad. At invitation time, he came down to the altar where Pastor Carlos led him to Jesus. As he hugged us tightly after services, he told us it was the best decision he ever made. He then shocked me as he asked me for a Pastoral letter that he could give to his boss so he could have service times off work to come and worship. Rafael and his family have been faithful and Pastor Carlos is working to disciple them through their questions about baptism as they have set under a lot of false teaching in the past.
