Field News

On December 7th I climbed on board a Douglas DC-3 at Missionary Flights Intl. in Fort Pierce, FL. This great organization helps missionaries with shipping and flights in the Caribbean. The purpose of this trip was to get things set up for our return early in 2022. We are excited to get back and continue working with missionaries Wesley and Melina Lane and the church plants there. Thanks to your faithful support and love offerings we were able to ship in over 1000 lbs of cargo including a 5,550 watt generator that the Lord gave us for a 1/3 of retail price and hoodies with our church name and logo on them. The congregation of Iglesia Bautista Agua Viva was absolutely ecstatic to receive them. It was neat to drive through town and see

the church's name on the backs of our people driving by on motos.

I spent two weeks in the DR and in that time was able to sign the lease to rent a 3 bedroom apartment and purchase a 2005 Honda Pilot. I enjoyed preaching and ministering with my Uncle Wes in Jarabacoa. We also made a trip to Mata de Cotui to visit Pastor Bonifacio and the congregation there. Please pray with them as they begin to search for land for a permanent home for their church. We also had the annual Christmas Dinner in Jarabacoa where we saw several first time visitors. We praise the Lord for providing these opportunities for us and through you.



One of the things that blessed my heart this trip was seeing that one of our young ladies, Jennifer, who is now a school teacher, had taught her class how to present the Gospel with water, dish soap, and cinnamon. This was an illustration that Teah and I had taught our young adults a few years ago. Greater yet was getting to see these little children sharing the illustration with their parents that walked by the class table during their school's presentation night. Isn't it incredible to witness the Lord multiplying your and our efforts before our very eyes? Thank you for your partnership, support, and prayers on our behalf!
